The Secretary retains the authority and jurisdiction to modify or cancel this approval for failure to comply with any of these items or other applicable laws and regulations.
- 4. This mining plan approval is binding on any person conducting coal development or mining operations under the approved mining plan and will remain in effect until superseded, canceled, or withdrawn.
- 5. If, during mining operations, unidentified prehistoric resources are discovered, the operator must ensure that the resources are not disturbed and must notify Montana DEQ and Office of Surface Mining Reclamation and Enforcement. The operator must take such actions as are required by Montana DEQ in coordination with the Office of Surface Mining Reclamation and Enforcement.
- 6. The Secretary retains jurisdiction to modify or cancel this approval, as required, on the basis of further consultation with the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service pursuant to section 7 of the Endangered Species Act, as amended, 16 U.S.C. § 1531 et seg.
