The current five-year term of the Kayenta Mine Permit AZ-0001F has an expiration date of July 6, 2025. Pursuant to the Code of Federal Regulations (CFR), Title 30, Chapter VII, Subchapter E, Part 750 and Subchapter G, Parts 773 and 774, enclosed please find seven (7) copies of an application for renewal of Surface Mine Permit AZ-0001F. Peabody Western Coal Company (PWCC) is requesting this permit be renewed for a five-year term (July 6, 2025 through July 5, 2030). No new permit area is proposed beyond that which is currently approved. No new coal leases are associated with this five-year permit term renewal application.

The application package contains all information required by 30 CFR 774.15(a) and (b) as listed in the enclosed Table of Contents. No additional updated information per 30 CFR 774.15(b)(2)(v) is included; however, PWCC will provide information as required by the Office of Surface Mining Reclamation and Enforcement Western Region (OSMRE) during their technical review. The renewal does not propose any revisions to the approved mining and reclamation plan. A notarized verification and certification statement is enclosed per 30 CFR 777.11(c), 778.9(a), (b), and (d), and 843.12. PWCC will also submit the enclosed proposed certification statement shortly before OSMRE issues the 5-year permit renewal.

According to 30 CFR 773.6(a)(b), 774.15(b)(2)(iv), and 778.21, once OSMRE has determined the application to be administratively complete, PWCC will commence the publication process and provide a complete application for public inspection. A copy of the approved newspaper advertisement and proof of publication shall be filed with OSMRE and shall be made part of the application within four weeks after the last date of publication.



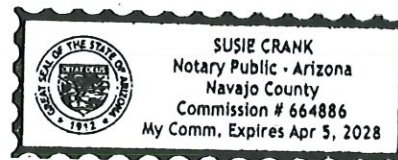

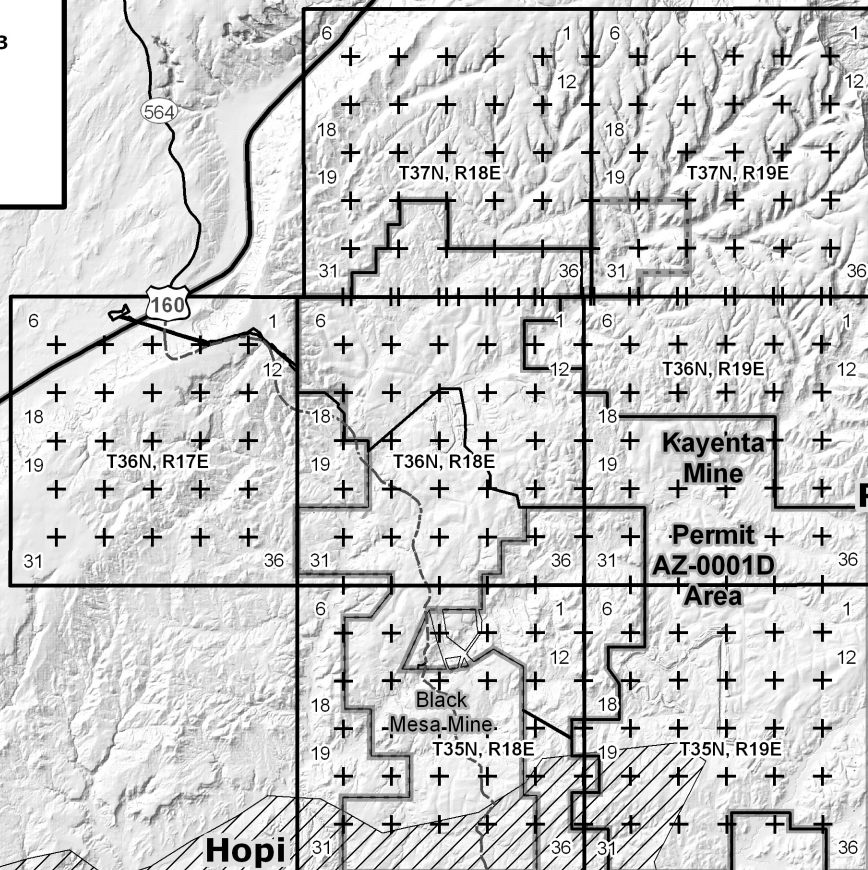
