



Solinst Water Level Meter



Description: The water-sensing probe is attached to a 300-foot polyethylene flat tape with permanent markings every 1/100 of a foot. A dial allows the buzzer to be adjusted or turned off when the probe is in cascading water and ensures a clear signal when the probe contacts high- or low-conductivity water. The tape is wound on a 10-inch diameter plastic reel with a brake.

Uses: The device measures depth to water in wells, boreholes, and shafts.

Maintenance: No routine maintenance required.
